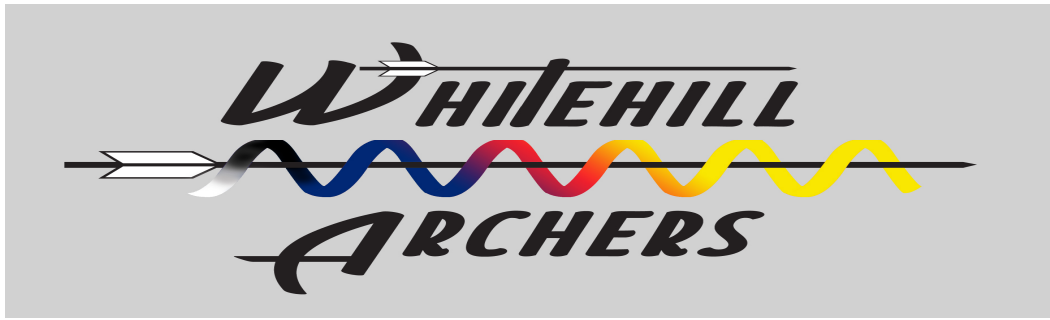




20th Christmas Pudding Shoot
